- Let them know about your differentiators
- Be prepared with solid examples; tell your story
- Challenge + Actions + Results
- Rehearse your answers to Tough Questions



- This is part of your due diligence such as
 - What does your best fit candidate look like?
 - Why is the position open?
 - What responsibilities in this job are really going to define success?
 - What skills and qualities will be the most important
 - Where do you see this division/company in the next five years?
 - What do you like and not like about working here?
 - Are there any additional questions for me?
